
Online Tutoring In ACES and in Canvas

Go to www.alamo.edu/spc and click on ACES LOGIN.




Login into ACES. If you have not login into ACES, Click on the link to the left to obtain your ACES User Name. The default password used when logging into ACES for the first is the first two letters of your last name in caps followed by month (2 digits), day (2 digits), and year of your birthday (2 digits).




If you have any problems with logging into ACES, contact the district support number at 210-485-0555.


You will come to a screen that looks like this.




You can now access Brainfuse directly by clicking on the **Brainfuse Online Tutoring** link under **Student Resources**. You can also access it through canvas.

This will take you into your canvas course.




On the left side, click on Brainfuse Online Tutoring link and follow the directions.
